Plan A Health clinics provide services to all patients regardless of insurance status or ability to pay. Patients without insurance are assessed on the sliding scale below, however a generous donation from the Ripple Foundation has covered the cost of all patient copays and fees through 2024.

For your reference, the sliding scale implemented for covered fees is below.

- 1. Find your family size on the left side of the chart (the number of family members who live in your house including you). For each additional family member, add \$393.33 monthly.
- 2. Read across that line/row to find your monthly income
- 3. Look down that column to the bottom row to see how much you owe. As a reminder this cost is covered by the Ripple Foundation.
